- The former 1970s Lufthansa building in the Deutz district of Cologne has been converted into the ultramodern maxCologne office complex. One of the office floors is visually and atmospherically striking due to the unusual choice of flooring in the form of gold- and anthracite-coloured carpet. The fine-quality, deep-pile and yet robust carpet from OBJECT CARPET made from Antron® fibres creates a pleasant spatial experience with impressive, positive acoustic characteristics. The bi-coloured design of the textile flooring gives the generous space a structured layout.

The attractive office floor was planned and designed by planning and interior design company 'designfunktion' of Bonn for and through collaboration with its users. The experts have succeeded in creating an interior concept that spatially complements company values, work processes and team spirit and harmonises with the unusual design of the 1970s architecture. The result is a modern working environment with well



thought-out details. Large window areas and floor-to-ceiling glass partitions make the office floor generous, light and transparent. The communicative core is a


frameless glazed conference area in the middle of the space. The interior designers have used the soft deep-pile OBJECT CARPET floor covering made from Antron® fibres to create an atmospheric feel. Its striking structure and elegant colour create a high level of well-being and a cosy atmosphere. At the same time it creates an aesthetically pleasing whole and a pleasantly quiet working atmosphere. Two exciting contrasting colours were deliberately chosen for the carpet in order to give the space a structured layout.

One of the office floors is visually and atmospherically striking due to the unusual choice of flooring in the form of gold- and anthracite-coloured carpet.

Around 560 m² of the office floor is fitted with elegant velour carpet in a warm golden colour.

This complements perfectly with the cool anthracite used for the space of around 90 m² in the functional areas which include the corridor, entrance and conference area.

→ Antron® carpet fibres with hollow filaments minimize soil accumulation and make dirt harder to see. The hollow filaments refract and diffuse light and hide the dirt while the specially designed surfaces readily release the dirt, making cleaning easier.
